


Roscommon Women's Network announces Camino & Dip

Roscommon Women's Network CycleUp Textiles team have launched the Athleague Camino & Dip, an outdoor event taking place on Sunday, July 20th.

The walk will start and finish at the Riverside Centre, the home of CycleUp Textiles. For those looking to embrace the full experience, there will be an optional refreshing dip in the water, offering a perfect way to cool down after the walk.

Nestled in the heart of County Roscommon, the River Suck winds through the landscape, perfect for the Athleague Camino and Dip. Surrounded by rolling green fields and rich heritage, it is a hidden gem of natural beauty and rural tranquillity while the adjacent village of Athleague offers timeless charm and welcoming community.

The event is suitable for children over 12 years old and no dogs are allowed on the route.

Funds raised from this event will directly support the Roscommon Women's Network, which works to empower and uplift women across the county through education, training, advocacy, and community ini-

tiatives. The proceeds will contribute to CycleUp Textiles, an innovative social enterprise that promotes sustainability and skill-building by upcycling materials while providing local employment opportunities.
